RANKRES COMS CAPT++ KIT CONTENTS 2x Rank Wording white lettering "COMMUNICATIONS" (1 small & 1 large)

RANK / POSITION: COMMUNICATIONS CAPTAIN

BEFORE GETTING STARTED

- Remove the helmets Face Shield if it's attached.
- Use a soft cloth to clean the helmet shell of dirt and debris that may prevent the decals from adhering properly. We're using a microfiber cloth for the purposes of these instructions.



RANK WORDING

RANK WORDING IS AVAILABLE IN DIFFERENT COLOURS AND CONFIGURATIONS DEPENDING ON YOUR RANK / POSITION. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THESE INSTRUCTIONS, 'COMMUNICATIONS' IS PICTURED.

- RW1. There are two stickers in the Rank wording kit one small text (a) and one large text (b).
- RW2. They are positioned on the helmet in the valley on either side of the second ridge from the center.
- RW3. Sticker "A", is the small text and has been resized to fit between the Easi On Off Torch Base and the front of the helmet.
- RW4. Run your thumb over the letters to ensure they are adhered to the face paper.
- RW5. Align the sticker with the edge of the Easi On Off Torch Base.
- RW6. Slowly and carefully remove the backing paper from the letters the adhesive side will now be exposed.
- RW7. Apply the sticker, aligned with the Easi On Off Torch Base.
- RW8. Continue with sticker "B", the large text.
- RW9. Run your thumb over the letters several times with the face paper still attached to make sure they are firmly adhered and to press out bubbles and creases.
- RW10. Remove the face paper.
- RW11. Looking at the front of the helmet align your second rank word with where the first one ended on the right hand side.
- RW12. Run your thumb over the letters on the second sticker a few times to ensure they're all adhered to the face paper and the sticker is ready for application.
- RW13. Slowly and carefully remove the backing paper from the letters.
- RW14. Apply the sticker, aligned with your first rank wording sticker.
- RW15. Run your thumb over the letters several times with the face paper still attached to make sure they are firmly adhered and to press out bubbles and creases.
- RW16. Remove the face paper.



















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
