

NSW RFS RANK DECAL APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

RANKRFS MEDIAOFFICER++ KIT CONTENTS

1x 25mm Black Band Set (3 stickers on single sheet)

2x Rank Wording Black lettering "MEDIA OFFICER"

1x 10mm Black Crown Strips Set (2 stickers on single sheet)

BEFORE GETTING STARTED

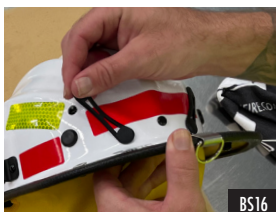
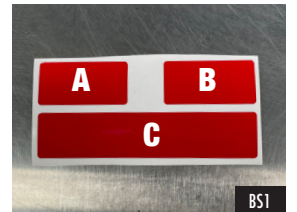
- Remove the helmets Face Shield if it's attached.
- Use a soft cloth to clean the helmet shell of dirt and debris that may prevent the decals from adhering properly. We're using a microfiber cloth for the purposes of these instructions.



25MM BAND SET

THE 25MM BAND SET IS AVAILABLE IN DIFFERENT COLOURS DEPENDING ON YOUR RANK / POSITION. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THESE INSTRUCTIONS, A RED BAND SET IS PICTURED.

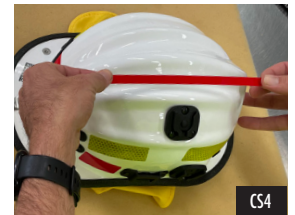
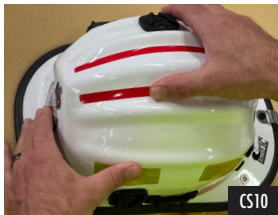
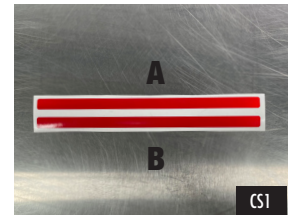
- BS1. The 25mm Band set is made up of 3 stickers, 2 short and 1 long.
- BS2. Remove sticker "A" (as indicated in BS1).
- BS3. Apply to the right side of the helmet, between the earmuff clip and the large black plug.
- BS4. The sticker should be positioned in the middle, between the clip and plug where the helmet shell meets the brim.
- BS5. Run your thumb over the sticker to press out bubbles and creases.
- BS6. Remove sticker "B" (as indicated in BS1).
- BS7. Apply to the left side of the helmet, between the earmuff clip and the large black plug.
- BS8. The sticker should be positioned in the middle, between the clip and plug where the helmet shell meets the brim.
- BS9. Run your thumb over the sticker to press out bubbles and creases.
- BS10. Remove both rubber accessory retention straps by gripping the strap and pulling the plug out of the hole, place them to the side.
- BS11. Remove sticker "C" (as indicated in BS1).
- BS12. Fold the sticker in the middle with the adhesive facing outward and pinch to crease in the center.
- BS13. Position the sticker just above the rivet in the rear of the helmet. The crease in the sticker should be centered in the middle of the center ridge.
- BS14. Let the sticker go so it settles on the helmet.
- BS15. From the center of the sticker out to the edge, use your thumb to fix to the helmet while pushing out air bubbles and creases.
- BS16. Replace the rubber accessory retention straps by pushing the plugs into the holes.



10MM CROWN STRIPS SET

THE 10MM CROWN STRIP SET IS AVAILABLE IN DIFFERENT COLOURS DEPENDING ON YOUR RANK / POSITION. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THESE INSTRUCTIONS, A RED STRIP SET IS PICTURED.

- CS1. The 10mm Crown Strip Set is made up of 2 stickers.
- CS2. They are positioned in the valley on either side of the center ridge of the helmet.
- CS3. Remove sticker "A" (as indicated in CS1).
- CS4. Align the sticker, centered in the valley on the right hand side of the center ridge.
- CS5. Affix the front of the sticker to the helmet, then guide sticker down onto shell with your other thumb, keeping centered in depression between the ridges.
- CS6. Run your thumb over the entire length of the sticker to press out bubbles and creases.
- CS7. Remove sticker "B" (as indicated in CS1).
- CS8. Align the front of sticker "B" with sticker "A" on the other side of the crown ridge. Center the strip in the valley on the left hand side of the center ridge.
- CS9. Affix the front of the sticker to the helmet, then guide sticker down onto shell with your other thumb, keeping centered in depression between the ridges.
- CS10. Run your thumb over the entire length of the sticker several times to press out bubbles and creases.



RANK WORDING

RANK WORDING IS AVAILABLE IN DIFFERENT COLOURS AND CONFIGURATIONS DEPENDING ON YOUR RANK / POSITION. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THESE INSTRUCTIONS, 'CADETS INSTRUCTOR' IS PICTURED.

RW1. In your rank decal kit, you would have received two stickers - both the same size.

RW2. We're going to apply them to the helmet in the valley on either side of the second ridge from the center.

RW3. Starting on the right side of the helmet you will find the entire rank word sticker will not fit in the space provided because of the Easi On Off Torch Base - so we need to split the word.

RW4. Looking at sticker "A" only, there are two defined words in your rank wording. Using a pair of scissors, cut the sticker to separate the two words.

RW5. Trim excess paper so the letters are close to the edges of the sticker.

RW6. Align the start of the second word with the right side of the Easi On Off Torch Base, in this example we're using the word 'INSTRUCTOR'.

RW7. Run your thumb over the letters a few times to ensure they're adhered to the face paper and the sticker is ready for application.

RW8. Slowly and carefully remove the backing paper from the letters - the adhesive side will now be exposed.

RW9. Apply the sticker, aligned with the Easi On Off Torch Base.

RW10. Run your thumb over the letters several times with the face paper still attached to make sure they are firmly adhered and to press out bubbles and creases.

RW11. Remove the face paper.

RW12. Align the end of the first word with the left side of the Easi On Off Torch Base, in this example we're using the word 'CADETS'.

RW13. Run your thumb over the letters with the face paper still attached.

RW14. Slowly and carefully remove the backing paper from the letters.

RW15. Apply the sticker, aligned with the Easi On Off Torch Base.

RW16. Run your thumb over the letters to ensure they're adhered to the face paper and the sticker is ready for application.

RW17. Remove the face paper.

RW18. Looking at the front of the helmet - align sticker "B" with where your rank word sticker finished on the other side of the helmet.

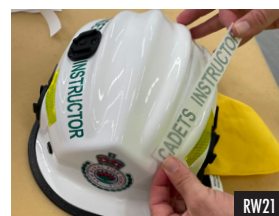
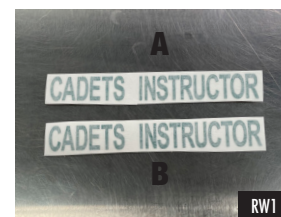
RW19. Run your thumb over the letters on the second sticker.

RW20. Slowly and carefully remove the backing paper from the letters.

RW21. Apply the sticker, aligned with your first rank wording sticker.

RW22. Run your thumb over the letters several times with the face paper still attached to make sure they are firmly adhered and to press out bubbles and creases.

RW23. Remove the face paper.
