As part of on-going work to improve manufacturing processes, delivery lead times and reduce waste, Pacific Helmets occasionally make modifications to products.

Certain models of helmets have in the past, been available with dyed-in shell colours. This process means that not only is the helmet painted in the desired colour, but that the colour is impregnated all the way through the composite matrix of the helmet and is visible on the inside as well.

The helmet that this is offered as standard on is the F3D MKII.

The process of accurately mixing colour pastes into the resin to make these helmets not only adds time to production lead times, it creates excess waste.

Going forward, the F3D MKII will be offered with the standard neutral coloured resin, as pictured. The neutral shell will only be visible on the inside / underside of the helmet.

The outside remains unchanged with Pacific Helmets high quality, UV stabilised paint to ensure a durable and UV resistant helmet.
